Richard is a broadcaster, writer and Church of England priest - but he's best known for having been one half of the 1980s band, **The Communards**. They enjoyed three UK Top 10 hits, including the biggest-selling single of 1986: Don't Leave Me This Way. Multi-talented, Richard turned his hand to acting, narrating Style Council's movie JerUSAlem. He also penned music for film and TV, served up advice as 'agony uncle' on BBC London and won a Sony Gold as presenter of The Mix on Radio 5 Live. The combination of a life in music and the media, and a life in religion, has the potential for interesting and amusing after dinner entertainment and Richard has built up a high reputation as an after dinner speaker.
